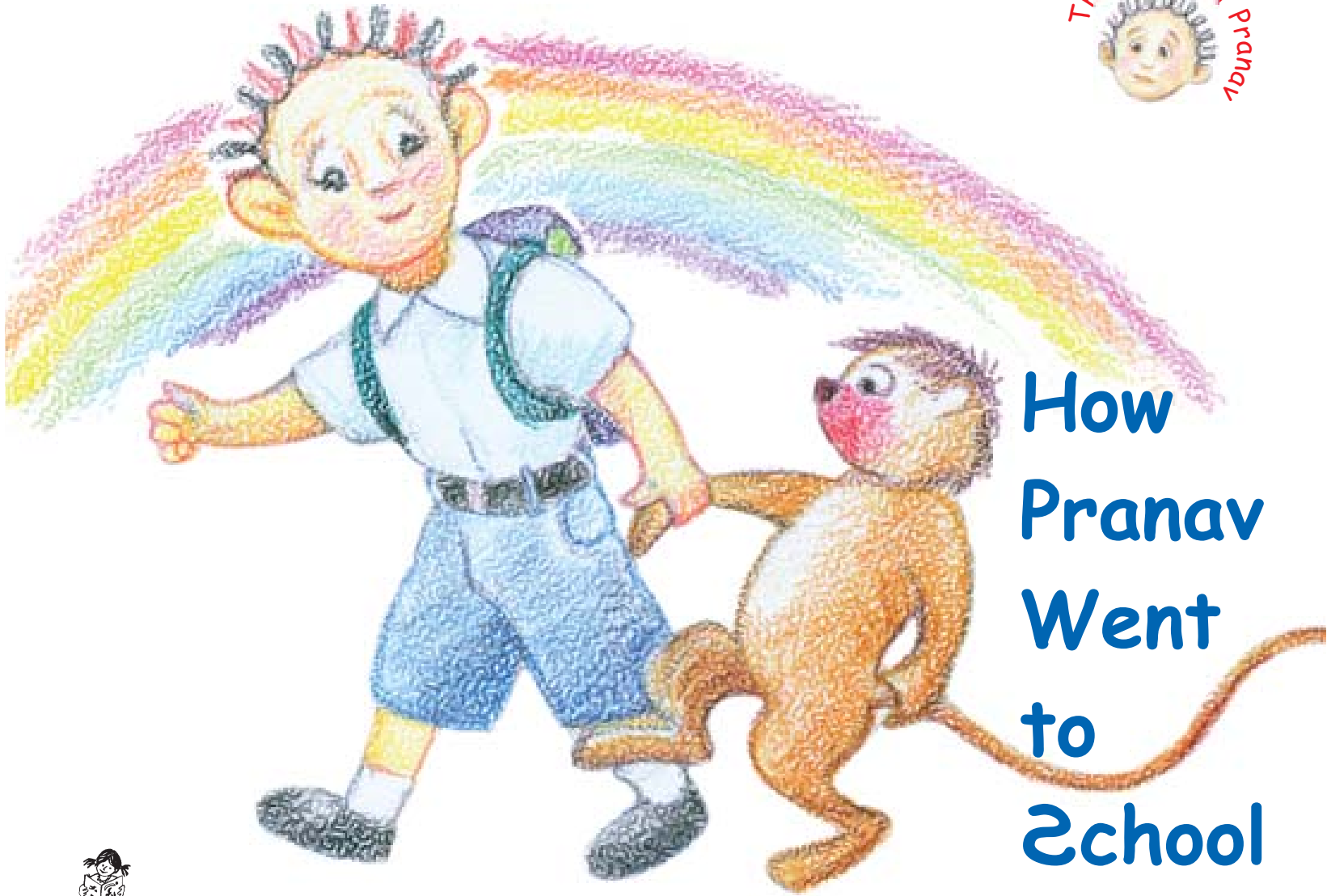

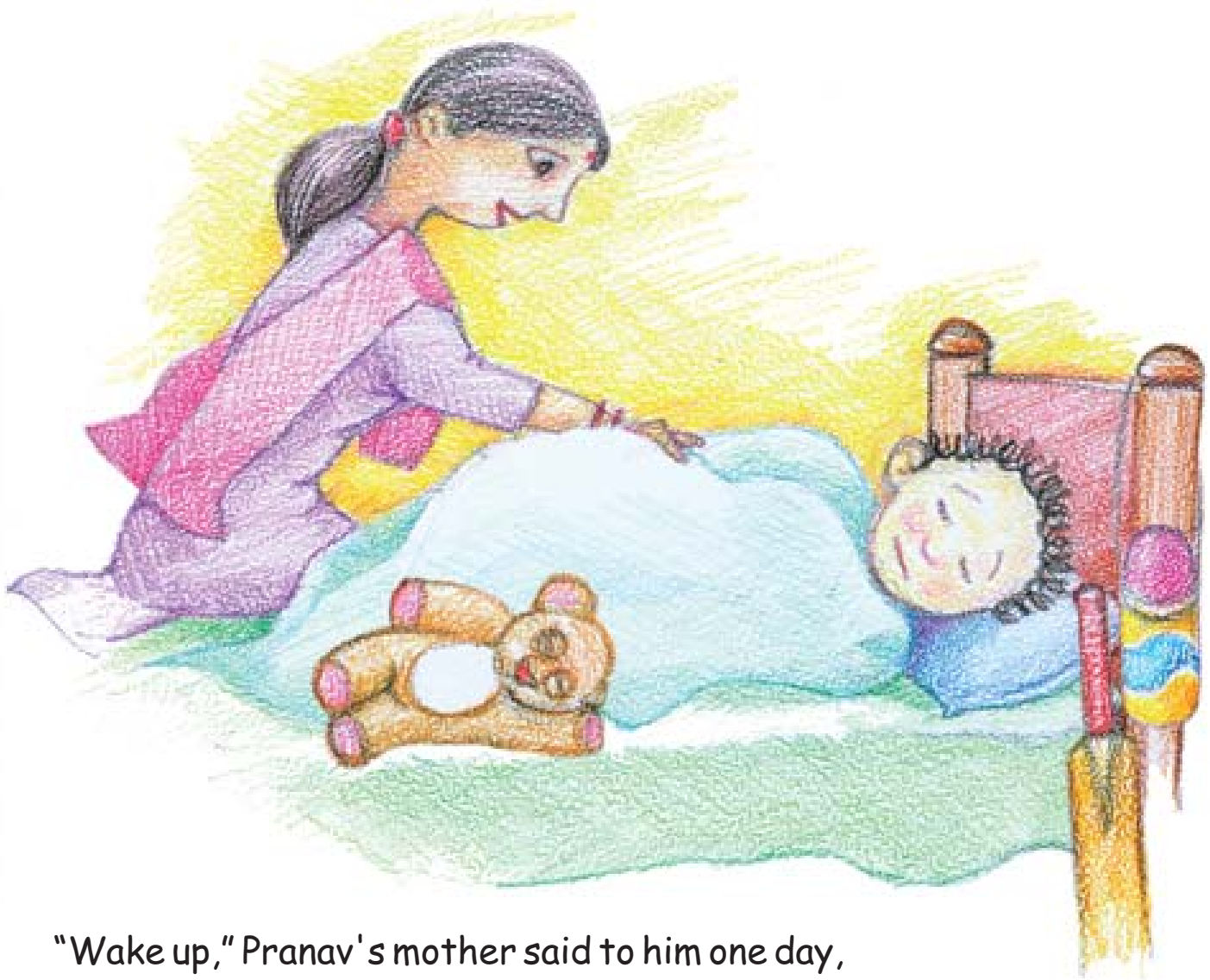

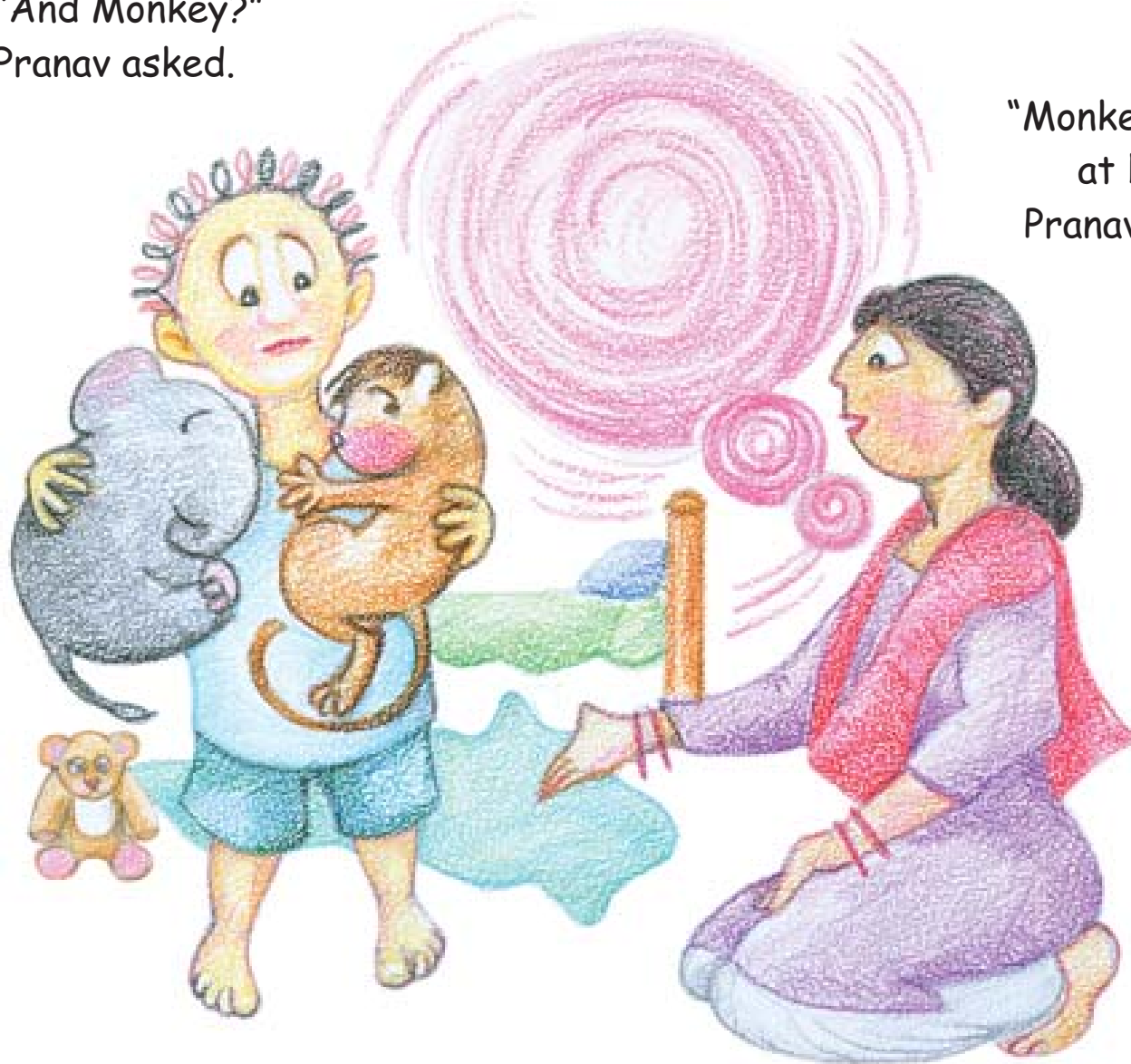
"Wake up," Pranav's mother said to him one day,

"Hatti won't go to school with you," Pranav's mother told him.

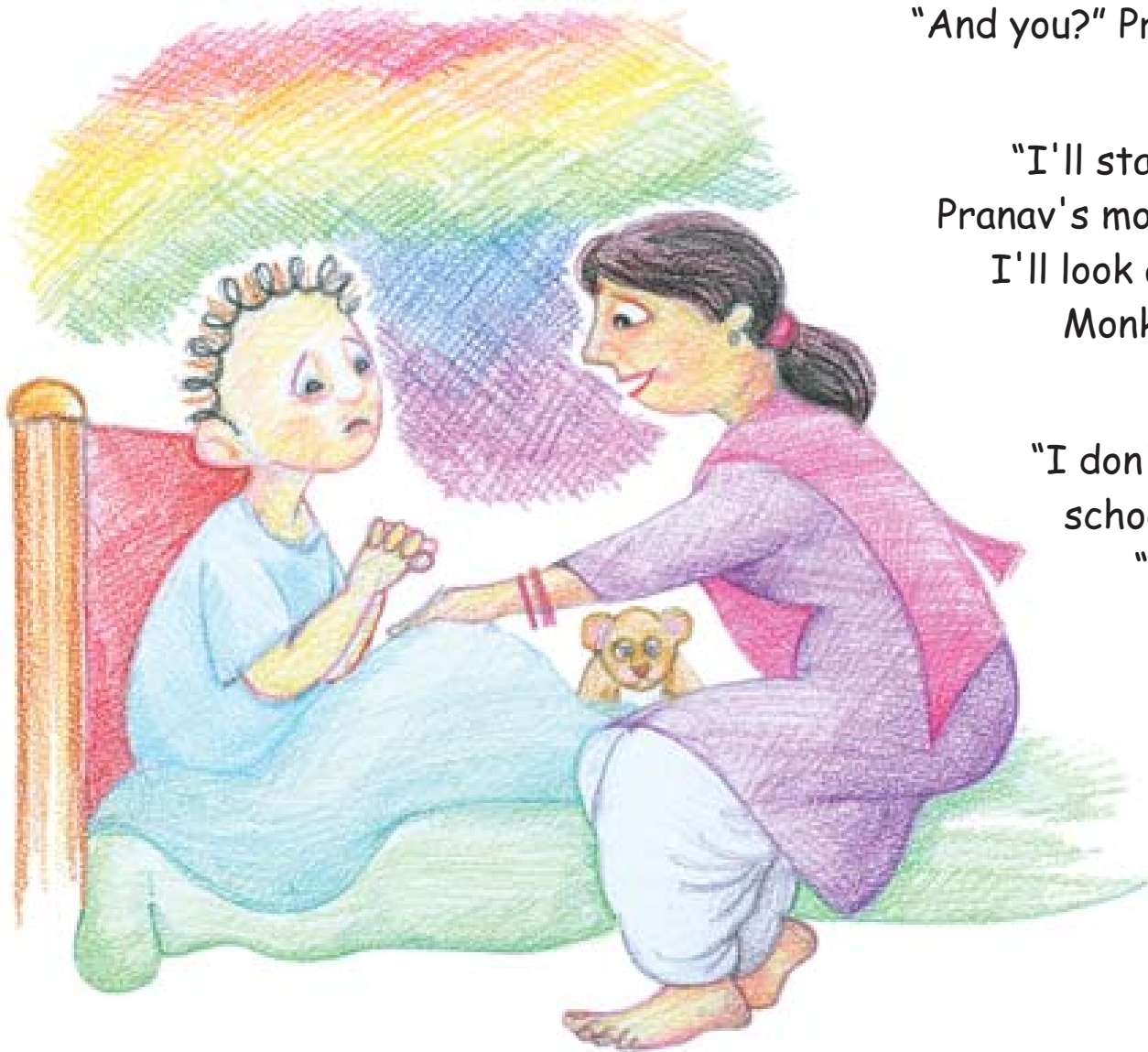
"Why can't he go with me?" Pranav asked.

"And you?" Pranav asked in a small voice.

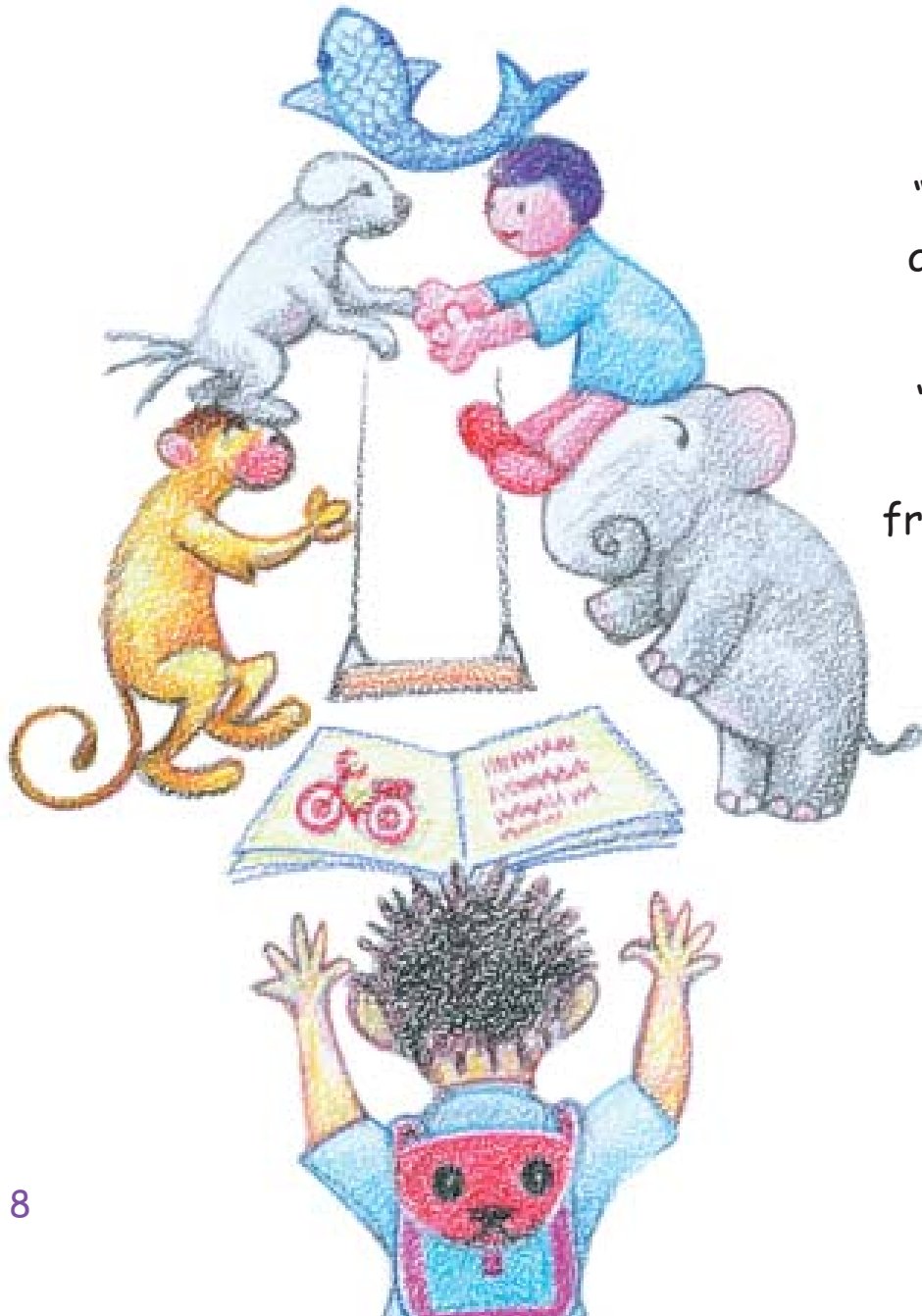
"I'll stay at home too," Pranav's mother said, "And I'll look after Hatti and Monkey and doll and your books!"

"There will be lots of other children there and new toys and..."

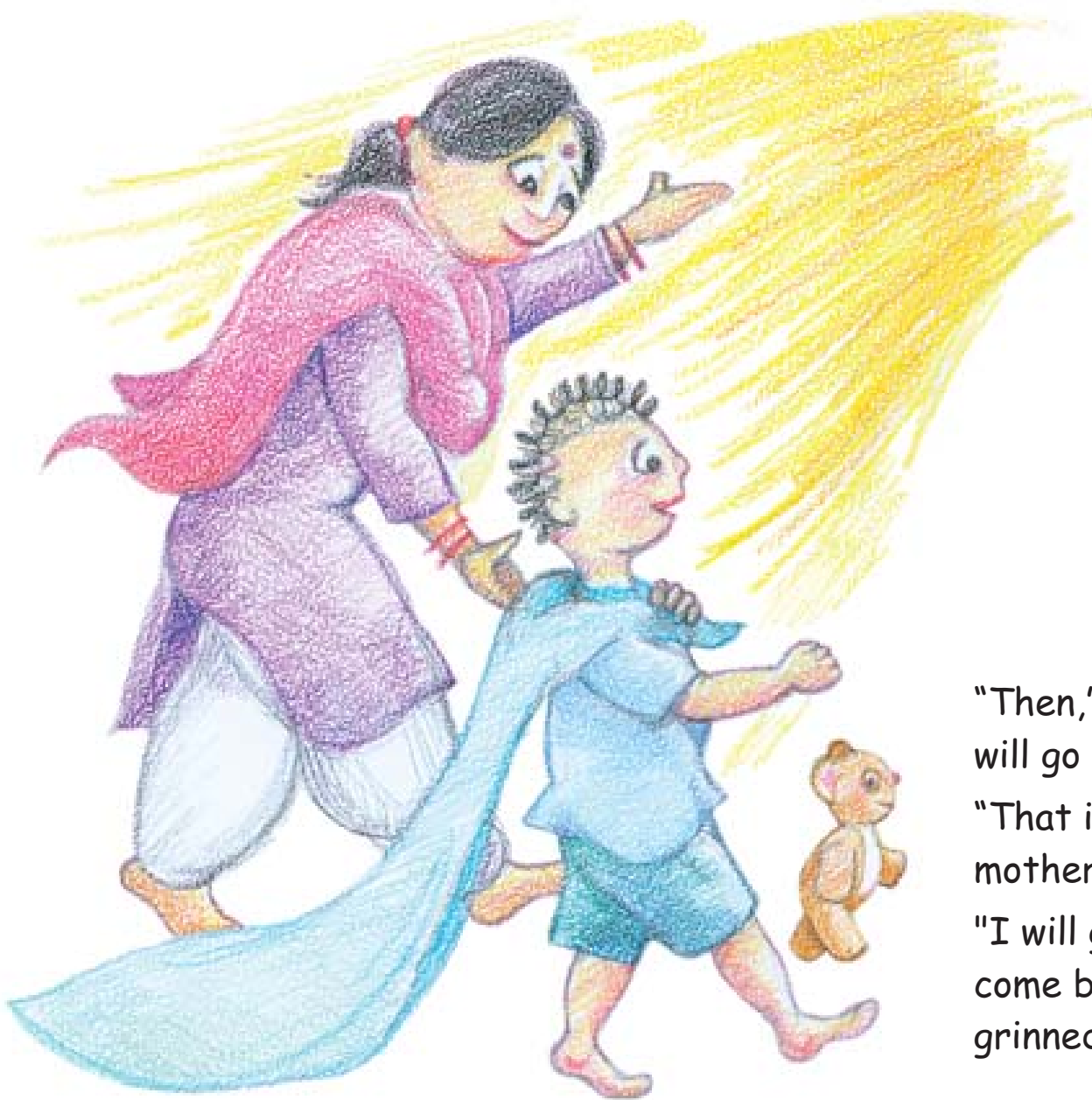


"But I don't want to leave you
