Soon they came to the bank of a stream.

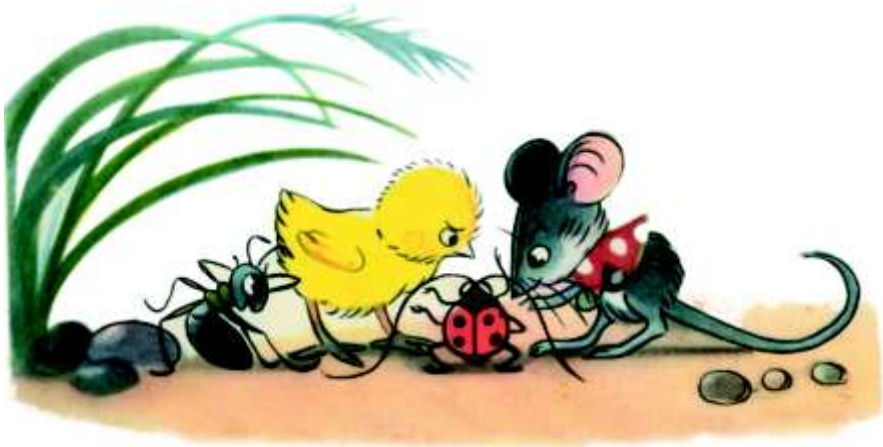


"Let's have a swim," said the frog,

with a leaf.

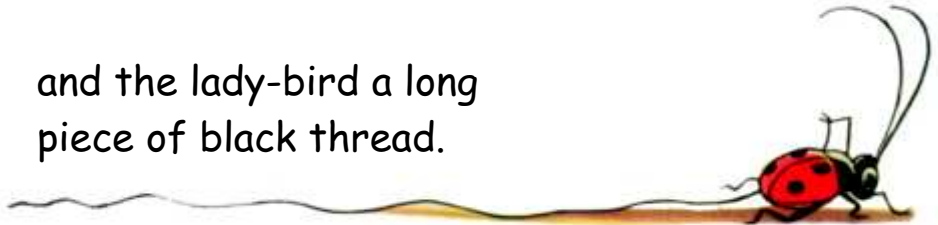
The mouse fetched

piece of black thread.

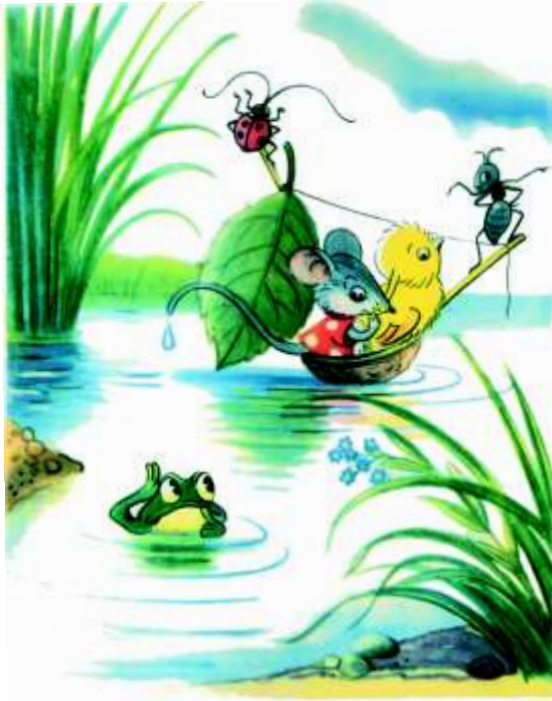
