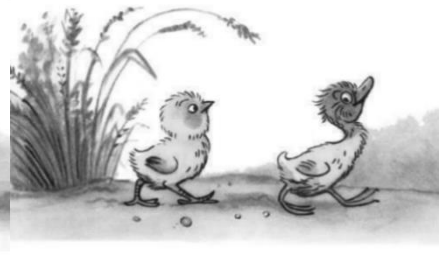

"Me, too," said the chick.



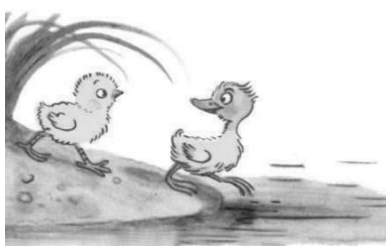
"I'm digging a hole," said the duckling.

"Me, too," said the chick.



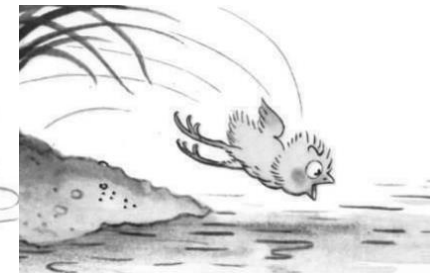
"I've caught a butterfly," said the duckling.
